Purpose of contract for a Geographical Names and Exonyms Management Consultant

To support EuroGeographics in the development of the database of Endonyms and other variant names (EVN) linked to EuroGeoNames gazetteer service as a part of European Location Framework (ELF) project.

Main Activities

- Continue to populate the existing database of exonyms and other variant names (EVN-DB) of EuroGeoNames and linking the names with their national standardized endonyms:
 - o for languages of countries currently available in EuroGeoNames
 - o for joining countries.

The aim is for all EuroGeographics member countries to contribute to EuroGeoNames in the long term.

- Define quality and quantity standards for the name forms of the geographical features in the EVN-DB and take steps to meet these standards by working with the national names authorities and toponymic experts.
- Provide communication and methodological support to the national naming authorities and toponymic experts.
- Maintaining and updating the manual of the EVN-DB.
- Carry out quality validation for the EuroGeoNames data and endonyms and the GeoLocator service in the European Location Framework (ELF) project.
- Implement changes in toponymic services for the existing EuroGeoNames service. Support the
 operation to combine the geographic names and endonyms in services (GeoLocator,
 GeoProductFinder) developed under the European Location Framework (ELF) project.
- With prior agreement with EuroGeographics the Consultant may also be involved to other activities related to utilisation of geographical names within the European Location Framework (ELF) project.

- Experience of working with European National Mapping and Cadastral Authorities;
- Experience of working in a multi-lingual, multi-national environment;
- A degree in geographical names or/and toponymic related subject;
- Experience in working in international bodies of national toponymic and geographic names experts;
